THIS IS WALTER...a Lhasa Apso who is lucky to be alive. He was found by a good Samaritan on the side of the road, after being hit by a car. She took him to the shelter, but they wouldn't take him in. They told her to take him to SPCA Hawthorne, who took him in and called us. Long story short, Walter has a horribly shattered pelvis (fractured in three places) and femur. Dr. Olds pinned him back together and he is now healing. He is a good boy...so sweet and gentle. Only 2 yrs old and so far, his life has been tragic...but it's looking up because he is in good, loving hands with LHH.

He is a happy go lucky lad, after being so sick...and he is playful like a puppy. He loves other dogs, is very curious about everything and his personality is still blossoming.
