He has a “high stepping” trot outside and is pretty quick on his feet! At adoptions, he kind of tramples over the other dogs and is like a comedian to watch! He gets along great with dogs and cats but doesn't need either in the house. He can be very vocal because his hearing has taken over for his eyes, so he likely would be better in a home vs. a condo or apartment. He likes to sleep a lot during the day...but when it comes time for dinner or treats...he's right in line with the rest of the crew!
